

Pre Anesthetic Information Sheet

- We require that all pets are current on vaccinations (Rabies and Distemper).
- We strongly recommend pre-anesthetic blood work to give us an inside look at some of your pet's vital internal organs. This testing is required for any pet 8 years of age and up.
- **Remove all food after 8pm the night before your pet's procedure**
- Remove water the morning of your pet's procedure
- Give extra time for your pet to go to the bathroom the morning of the procedure.
- Our surgery check-in time is 7:45am. Please allow extra time to complete the surgery consent/pre-anesthetic testing form and speak with the surgery technician about your pet's scheduled procedure. The surgery consent form can be printed from our website or filled out the morning of the procedure.
- You will receive a call from your pet's doctor when the procedure has been completed; please make sure to leave a number where you will be available.
- We ask that you call after 3pm the day of your pet's surgery to set up a discharge time for your pet.
